- ✓ To collaborate with other education institutions/organizations and agencies regionally and nationally;
- ✓ To monitor ongoing activities related to language retention and preservation and provide briefings to the Education Steering Committee and Governing Board of Chiefs;
- ✓ To participate as a team member of the Anishinaabeg of Kabapikotawangag Resource Council.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- ✓ Must have Anishinaabemowin as first language; demonstrate fluency & written
- ✓ A strong understanding and commitment to the principles of the Anishinaabeg of Kabapikotawangag;
- ✓ Must have a degree/diploma in education and/or Native Language Instructor Program;
- ✓ Must have experience in classroom environment teaching the Ojibway language and demonstrate the curriculum development
- ✓ Excellent communication, organization, and computer skills.
- ✓ Understanding and knowledge of the Ojibway customs, traditions and values.
